



HIE Help Center Scholarship for Special Educators

The HIE Help Center will award one annual scholarship in the amount of \$1,000 to an undergraduate or graduate student who is pursuing a career in special education.



Applications are reviewed once a year, with the deadline of July 31st. The scholarship will be awarded to an applicant who meets the following requirements.

Scholarship Eligibility

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Cannot be a past, present, or future client of ABC Law Centers (the firm sponsoring the HIE Help Center)
- Be seeking or in the process of completing higher education at an institution in the United States (either as an undergraduate or graduate student) in special education. High school seniors are also welcome to apply if they already know which college or university they will be attending.
- Have a GPA of at least 3.0
